The new business unit also has access to injection molding presses up to 3,500 tons through its sister division, SA Engineering, who has partnered with Engel Machinery, Inc. to showcase their equipment in a state-of-the-art tryout facility in Detroit.

"We are the only additive supplier capable of demonstrating the performance of our materials in a commercial-scale environment, and we do that in-house in a controlled situation," McCormack said.
